

Operation Catnip Peterborough: DRIVER

We need sensible, patient people who understand the purpose and limitations of Trap-Neuter-Return and are willing to work within our mandate.

The feral and abandoned cats we serve can seldom be handled like fully socialized cats. For the safety and protection of everyone involved, including vet techs, vets, trappers, and the cats themselves, these animals must be trapped and transported in cages (traps).

Training and mentoring is provided!

DUTIES:

- Receive instructions from Trapping Coordinator (e.g., caregiver address).
- Pick up cat from post-op space (in trap already) between 8 and 8:45 a.m.
- Deliver to designated vet clinic.
- Return to pick up cat from vet between 3 and 5:30 p.m.
- Deliver cat back to caregiver or post-op space, relaying any information and medication to other volunteers.

NOTE: All cats are in secure, humane TNR traps. You will not be required to touch or handle the cats. Most of our vet partners are located within Peterborough, though we occasionally need to use the services of out-of-town vets.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Have reliable transportation and a valid driver's licence.
- Be willing to travel throughout the City of Peterborough.
- Be able to carry a 10lb cage with the weight of a cat inside.
- Be willing to shadow an experienced transporter for one or two trips before starting.
- Sign a liability release form.
